

Ownership & Responsibility

This document outlines the responsibilities of the purchaser once a stretch tent has been installed by The Shire Canopy Company. Please read carefully and retain for your records.

Transfer Of Responsibility:

Upon completion of the installation of your structure, the responsibility for its maintenance, safety, and insurance transfers to you, the purchaser. This includes, but is not limited to:

Insurance: You are responsible for insuring the stretch tent against all potential risks, including damage from weather, vandalism, and accidental damage. We strongly recommend consulting with your insurance provider to ensure adequate coverage.

Weather Monitoring: You are responsible for regularly monitoring local weather forecasts, particularly regarding high winds, heavy rain, or snowfall.

Decision Making: You are responsible for making informed decisions regarding the safety of the structure during adverse weather conditions. This includes determining whether the structure needs to be temporarily taken down.

High Wind and Adverse Weather Procedures:

The structures, while robust, can be affected by high winds and extreme weather. It is crucial to take the following precautions:

Wind Speed Awareness: Familiarise yourself with the wind speed limitations of your specific tent model. Information about these limits can be provided by The Shire Canopy Company upon request.

Temporary Takedown: In the event of forecasted high winds exceeding the tent's limitations, or other severe weather conditions, you are responsible for deciding if temporary takedown is necessary.

Notification to The Shire Canopy Company (If Agreed): If you have agreed with The Shire Canopy Company that they will take the tent down in adverse conditions, it is your responsibility to notify them in a timely manner, providing ample notice before the anticipated weather event.

Emergency Takedown: In the event of sudden and severe weather, you are responsible for taking immediate action to ensure the safety of people and property. This may include attempting to temporarily secure or partially dismantle the tent if safe to do so.

The Shire Canopy Company is not responsible for any damage or injury resulting from the failure to properly monitor weather conditions, take appropriate safety precautions, or secure adequate insurance coverage after the installation of the stretch tent.
